PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear brothers and sisters,  
Today's invitation is clear: to place our trust in God. Although it might not sound surprising, we should think carefully about this. Our natural tendency is always to trust in our experience: what we control, what we feel, what we possess. But there are times when we are called to trust not based on our human securities, but on God's word. This is the meaning of today's words: cursed is the one who trusts in human beings.

The beatitudes are perhaps the most powerful example of this reality: Jesus describes the path of discipleship in a way that no human being could possibly find "natural", or "spontaneous". There is no way of embracing this path if not by faith, by trust in the promises of God, in the eternal life of the resurrection witnessed by St. Paul in the second reading. We believe in Christ and follow Him because He is risen, alive and powerful.

Let us renew our trust in God, and our lives will be like a tree, planted near running waters.
