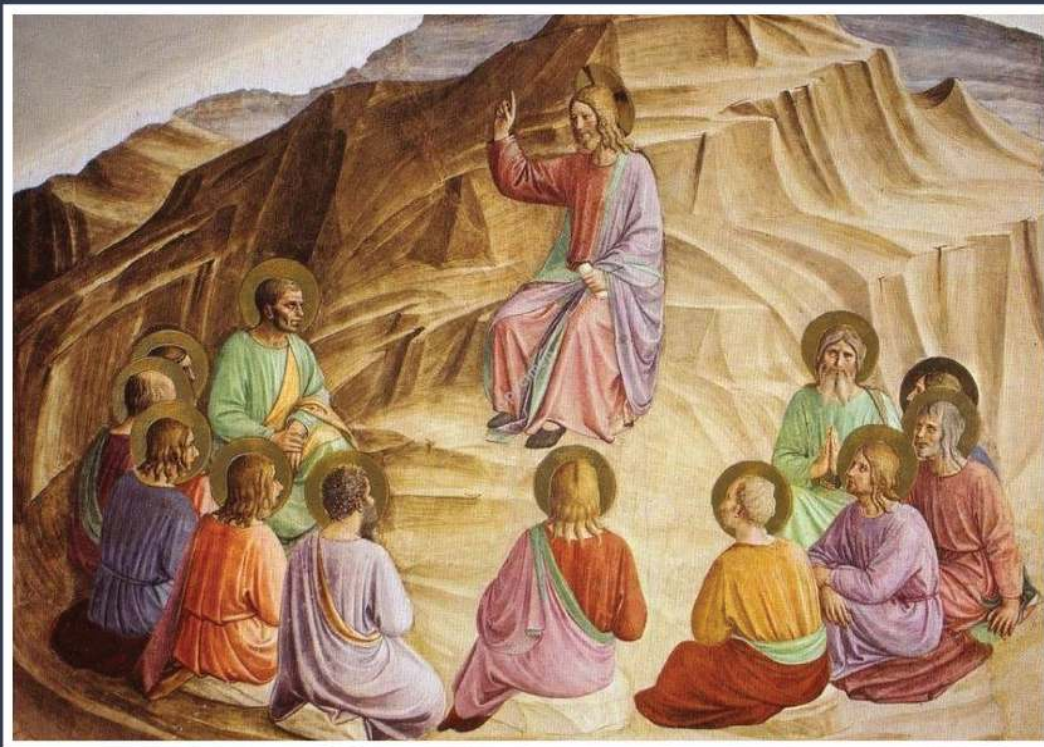

PASTOR’S CORNER

Dear friends in Christ,

Today we continue to hear the challenging words that follow the teaching of the Beatitudes. What the Lord says to us today is no less counter-cultural than what we heard last week. We need to love our enemies; do good to those who hate us; pray for those who mistreat us. This is so difficult! But the point is simple: we are called to be merciful like our merciful Father. Simply put: we are not called to be just like most people are. “Normal,” or “average,” are not the criteria for a disciple of Christ. We are called to be different; to not do that which would seem “justifiable,” or “understandable.” Doing what feels “normal,” (such as not being good to someone who mistreats us), is of no credit to us. There is nothing generous, nothing gracious, nothing special about it. In other words, there is no reward, as it is the normal thing to do, or as Jesus put it, as even sinners do the same. But we do want a “credit,” a reward for eternal life, and for that, we choose, with God’s grace, to try to be merciful like our merciful Father.

This challenging vocation is certainly hard, but also beautiful and exciting. Nothing else will give us eternal joy; nothing else will bring renewal to the Church.
