PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear brothers and sisters,  
 Today is the first Sunday of Lent, and the liturgy takes us to the desert. We were first reminded of the origins of our faith: our ancestors wandered in the desert, went to Egypt, and were liberated by God who gave them a land, sign of his providential love.

As Jesus began his public ministry He was led by the Spirit into the desert, where He was tempted. When every year we read the Gospel of the temptations of the Lord we do it not because the Church encourages us to be tempted, but because we need to go into the desert, and be aware of our weakness, so we can find our strength not in ourselves, but in God, in his word and sacraments. Lent has to be a different time, it has to feel like a desert, a time of purification, of more silence and reflection, of extra prayer and charity, a time where we go from one place to another. At the end of this time there is the promised land of Easter. So may our efforts be fruitful as we enter generously into this desert, and may we rejoice as we celebrate Christ's resurrection.
