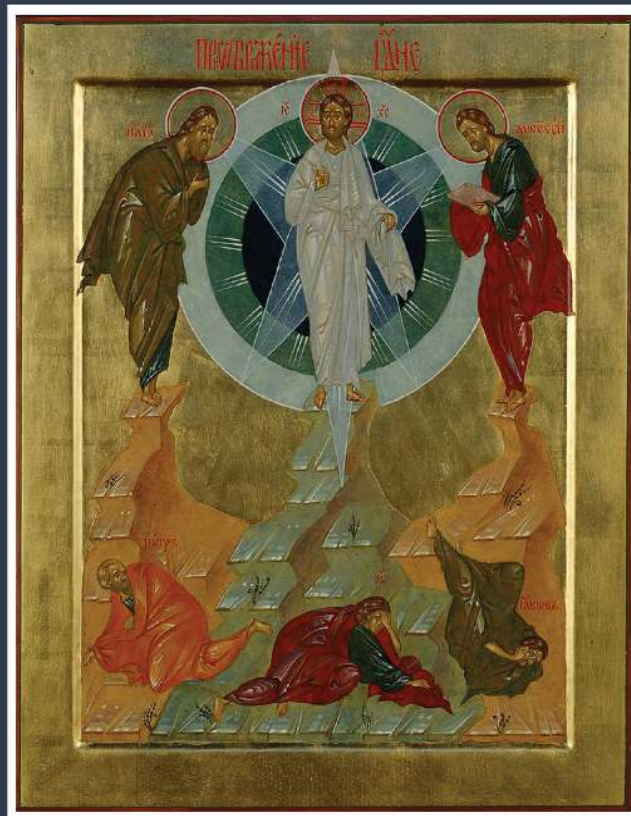

PARISH NEWS

Did You Know: The first priest to minister to Catholics in this area was Fr. Ignatius Grom, a missionary priest from Santa Fe, who served as chaplain at Loretto Height Academy. At the end of 1894 (125 years ago), four Catholics obtained a plot of land at the corner of South Irving Street and Mansfield Avenue (what is now the west side of our parking lot) and began plans to build St. Patrick's Catholic Church. It was a one-story partially below ground church, built of Castle Rock limestone. The Parish was St. Patrick's until 1960 when the current church was built.

PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear friends,

Greetings from Greece! We've had a wonderful time in this pilgrimage following the steps of St. Paul. We have visited the places where the Apostle preached the Gospel, and also the house of Mary in Ephesus. At every place we have been praying for all of you.

Today we observe the second Sunday of Lent, and the Lord takes us to the mountain to see and hear something remarkable: Jesus is the true God. Yes, He is one of us, and He will suffer and die. But He will rise, for He is God himself. The apostles saw his glory shining in the splendor of the mountain, and heard that voice that only resounded a few times in the Gospel: the Father himself giving testimony of Jesus – This is my beloved Son.

He is the beloved Son: to Him do we follow, to Him do we obey and love. Because of Him we work hard during Lent to purify our hearts through fasting, prayer, and charity. Only because of Him, because we too want to see the splendor of his resurrection.

May the transfiguration help us to remain steadfast in the Lenten observances.
