PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear brothers and sisters,

Lent is a time for conversion, a period that calls for real purification of our hearts. Because of this, it demands a realistic disposition: we need to know the truth of our actions, and the possible consequences. The Gospel helps us to see this.

Jesus told a parable about a fig tree that gives no fruit. Its owner is tired and wants to cut it down. The gardener intercedes and asks for another year of work, hoping it will bear fruit. If not, they will cut it down.

We are called to bear fruit not only in terms of our work, but especially in our hearts: the fruit of love, of conversion, of prayer, of charity, of fidelity. A life without fruit will have consequences. Because of that, Lent is like that time obtained by the loving patience of the gardener, who wants to work hard so that the tree can bear fruit. We should respond to this new opportunity and work for some fruits of growth and conversion. Jesus, our gardener, will be working hard; He needs our cooperation.
