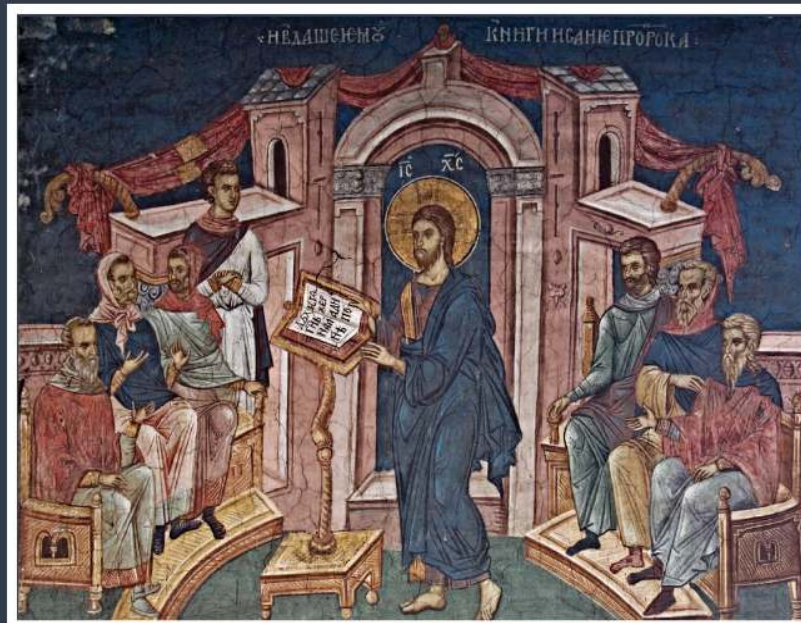

PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear friends in Christ,
