PASTOR’S CORNER

Dear brothers and sisters,

On this Laetare Sunday in which we are called to rejoice as we see the days of salvation approach, the Lord gives us the “pearl of the Gospel,” the most wonderful parable that shows us the real reason for rejoicing: the prodigal son. As we hear again that God is a merciful Father, that He lovingly respects our freedom and is always waiting for us to go ever more deeply into his heart, the Church cannot but show this joy in ways that we can perceive with our senses: the organ sounds more than other Lenten days, rose vestments are worn, and flowers adorn the altar again. The Church rejoices today for in a few days we will accompany again the Lord in his sorrowful passion, his death, and resurrection. We rejoice because we will witness Jesus paying the price of the mercy we receive today through the sacraments.

Hopefully this joy will be a reality in our hearts, and will move us to renew our efforts for a fruitful Lenten season.
