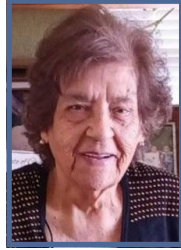
A REFLECTION ON EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL THURSDAY, JANUARY 25, 7:00 PM

IN MEMORY OF: JOSEFA ESPARZA LUNA

Funeral services were held for parishioner Josefa Esparza Luna of Littleton on January 12, 2024. Msgr Bernard

Schmitz celebrated the funeral Mass in Spanish, preceded by the recitation of the Holy Rosary.

Josefa was born in Zacatecas, Mexico on June 28, 1933, to Vidal and Maria Dolores Esparza. She grew up in Valparaiso, Mexico with ten siblings and was married to Francisco Luna who died in 1965. They had six children, Rosa Maria, Eladio, Francisco, Eva, Tina, and Maria Dolores that she raised as a single mother. She had 12 grandchildren and 13 great-grandchildren. Josefa lived in California before moving to Denver in 1993. She died on December 29, 2023, and was buried in Olinger Crown Hill Cemetery in Wheat Ridge.

FROM FR. DANIEL

Dear friends,

After last Sunday's wonderful story of the first encounter of Jesus with his disciples, today we read the story of their call. Last Sunday, John told us of that day, when at four in the afternoon, he and Andrew met Jesus and stayed with Him, and then went to Peter to tell him that they had found the Messiah. We do know that that day changed their lives but we do not know much more.

Today's Gospel tells us of that other day when the Lord went to those whom He had met, but now to solemnly call them to become his disciples: *Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men.* At that point, they left everything, their families and work, and became disciples of Jesus, walking with Him and following Him wherever He went.

We, who already know Jesus, hear again his call today. While it may mean different things for each of us, his call certainly leads us to a deeper faith and love; while we have said yes, today's call invites to leave whatever might be an obstacle to following Him; even though we believe in Him, He wants to give us more, He needs us for his mission. May we be open to his call, and follow Him today.
