OUR FEBRUARY MOTHER'S STORY

Jodie* came to Marisol Health for a free pregnancy test. She was uncertain about what life would mean for her and her boyfriend if she was pregnant. After discovering a positive pregnancy test, Jodie had an ultrasound and visit with our team, sharing "my boyfriend drinks a lot. I don't want to leave him, but I'm so depressed and anxious about our relationship. I just wish he'd get better." Jodie began to meet with the Marisol Health Family Development Specialist who referred her to a Marisol Health licensed therapist to begin the healing journey of processing her emotions, reminding her of her dignity and self worth, and helping her to have healthy communication and relationship patterns. Jodie continued to be seen at Marisol for her medical appointments while working towards her goals. She reported, "I want to be the best mom I can be for my toddler and this new baby. It feels like hard work, but I'm grateful I'm not alone." Jodie is due in March 2024 and, with the support of our team, is moving towards becoming who she knows she really is.

A SVDP Story: Belinda's Story

Belinda's story began in Texas, a broken marriage but children grown and on their own. She had relatives in Kansas, and worked there for a while before coming to Denver. She was living at the women's shelter run by Catholic Charities on 48th Street when she found a job in southwest Denver. She paid the weekly rate at a residential motel while saving up for a deposit for an apartment. Then she came down with covid and could not return to work until she tested negative - unfortunately (and we hear this too often) the employer could not wait. She was replaced and now, without a job and unable to pay the weekly room rate, it would be back to the shelter. She called our St Vincent de Paul conference and we stepped in to cover 2 weeks in the hope that she might find a new job quickly. She did – but we couldn't cover the gap until the first paycheck. It was bittersweet to know she was possibly returning, temporarily, to the shelter, but she was grateful to have had a decent room while she did the job search. We sent her off with several pairs of scrubs from ARC - and hopes that she was "dressed for success".
