FROM FR. DANIEL

Dear friends in Christ,

Today's liturgy shows us the radical newness of Christ. Not only does He heal a leper when this man broke the conventions of his time and approached Jesus, but He decided to stretch out his hand and touch him. This was forbidden by the Law, but Jesus was more than the old Law. By touching the leper—which of course He had no need to do in order to heal him—Jesus offered a different kind of healing: He restored the poor man to communion, breaking the exclusion and loneliness to which the leper had been condemned. Having healed his heart, He healed his body, and the poor man could not stop sharing the good things He had received from Christ.

This radical newness is not old: Christ still stretches out his hand to touch those areas of loneliness and shame, reconciling our hearts and offering new life. May we be open to the renewal of this gift that mysteriously takes place at this Mass. May we share the good things the Lord has done in our lives.
