FROM FR. DANIEL

Dear friends in Christ,

The Lord does something surprising in today's Gospel: He expels the merchants from the Temple. As we heard, He does it with strength, moved by his ardent zeal for his Father.

A common way to understand this action is that Jesus wanted to purify the Temple for the excesses of those merchants. But, in reality, He was doing something more important and more decisive: He was purifying worship itself. As we know, worship in the Temple in fact required animals for sacrifice; for those coming from afar for Passover, money changers were necessary so people can purchase the animals. So Jesus was not simply going against some excess, but against the very way in which worship was performed. He was acting as the Lord and the Messiah, who came to establish "the fullness of divine worship," the one "worship in spirit and in truth," the liturgy of the Church with the new sacrifice at its center: the most Holy Eucharist.

As we contemplate this event, let's appreciate the gift of the new sacrifice of the Lamb, so that through our Lenten observances, we may be better disposed to celebrate its institution on Holy Thursday.

SVDP Story: Counting on that Tax Refund!

Mary Ellen is a 40-year-old single mother of 4 boys, ages 10 to 16. She earns approximately \$21/hr working a night shift at a bakery. She had several setbacks in the last year. Her (uninsured) car needed repairs after an accident, and because she works nights, she needed to get the car repaired and had to use Uber while it was in the shop. She also lost time due to covid. She rents a condo from a private party who has been quite lenient, but now that the past due has come to \$2,600, there needs to be some effort to catch up. We spoke with the owner, and she will accept our partial payment of \$1,200 with the understanding that Mary Ellen will file her taxes and come up with the remaining \$1,400. We were able to make the \$1,200 payment thanks to your donations, as well as gifts from the Ozanam Housing Fund and the SVdP at St Thomas More and Light of the World parishes.
