**IN MEMORY OF PAT MURPHY
NOVEMBER 16, 1940 - MARCH 2, 2024**

Funeral services will be held Monday, March 18, for parishioner Patricia (Ziolkowski) Murphy with visitation at 10 am, recitation of the rosary 10:30 am and the funeral Mass at 11 am. A reception will follow after Mass and the committal service at Fort Logan National Cemetery will follow the reception.

Pat was born on November 16, 1940, in Rockvale, Colorado. She attended Rockvale Elementary School and Florence High School. She was married to Edmond on May 4, 1968, at St. Theresa’s Catholic Church in Aurora. They were the parents of Scott Murphy and Tracie Murphy who died in 1991. Pat worked as an administrative secretary at various locations including Denver General Hospital and the Association for Retarded Citizens.

Pat died on March 2, 2024, while living at Cherrylyn Nursing Home.

FROM FR. DANIEL
