

Serving our Neighbors in Need

We want to help you get to know more about our SVDP conference and their efforts by featuring a story from one of our neighbors in need each month.

#### A SVDP Story: Nancy's Story

Nancy is 52 years old and has been disabled since 2014. She was hospitalized for a month last summer because of a brain aneurysm; for a few months thereafter she was unable to earn the small amounts she usually earns (cleans her church, \$100/wk; cuts hair, perhaps \$300/mo). She has not fully recovered her cognitive and speech abilities. Her disability benefit is \$33 more than her \$1,033 mortgage payment. Her 20-year-old truck needed its transmission rebuilt, her roof leaks, and trees need to be cut back from power lines on her property. If she pays \$2,600 for the truck repair, she won't be able to cover her normal household expenses and she would deplete the savings for the roof repair and tree trimming. Thanks to your donations and a matching fund for vehicle repairs available from the Denver Metro SVdP Council, we were able to pay \$1,000 toward the vehicle repair, thus freeing up the cash for her household bills and partially restoring the savings for the roof repair and tree trimming, both of which pose safety issues.

## THE ARCHDIOCESE OF DENVER OBSERVES THE 50<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY OF PERMANENT DEACONS

Sunday marks the 50th anniversary of the first deacons ordained in the AOD. The Archdiocese of Denver observes the fiftieth anniversary of the first permanent deacons for the Archdiocese which took place on April 6, 1974. The Vatican II Council had called for restoring the order of the diaconate as a "particular and permanent rank of the hierarchy" with its own "indelible character and its own special grace" so that those called to it "can permanently serve the mysteries of Christ and the Church". Over the 50 years, 288 men have been ordained to serve as permanent deacons in the Archdiocese. Among the first eleven men ordained in Denver was Howard Tirgrath, a parishioner of Holy Name Church. Other men who have served Holy Name are Gordon Milhone, Sam Lopez, Jack Sutton, Tim Kilbarger, and Donald Schaefer. Please pray for the 176 deacons who now serve in the Archdiocese!
