Dear brothers and sisters,

**FROM FR. DANIEL**

Today we celebrate the great solemnity of Pentecost. 50 days after the resurrection, we remember the powerful event that brought the paschal mystery to fulfillment: the coming of the Holy Spirit upon the nascent Church. But, of course, we do more than remember. In a mysterious, real but different way, we believe that the Holy Spirit comes again to us. The question is, are we open to his coming? For this is more than a pious exercise. The Holy Spirit is fire, and fire burns, fire is something we can't fully control. But, just as without fire we have no light and warmth, so the Church cannot exist without the Spirit. In the same way, each portion of the Church cannot really live and thrive without the fire of the Spirit. So today is an occasion for all of us to pray and be truly open to receiving the Holy Spirit, so that He can guide us to all truth and strengthen us with his gifts. In that way, we will be able to be who we are called to be as a parish community.

Come Holy Spirit, come again through Mary!
