Dear friends, **FROM FR. DANIEL**

Greetings from Rome, where I am busy working for the week. I always pray for you and hope you pray for me.

After the conclusion of the wonderful days of Eastertide, the Church gives us a few other delightful solemnities to extend the joy of the resurrection: today, the Most Holy Trinity, the following Sunday, Corpus Christi, and the following Friday, the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus.

It is as if the light of the resurrection allows our poor eyes to see more directly some of the mystery of God himself, the unexpected good news that God is a Community of Love, One God and Three Persons. Then, we will contemplate how the Son stays with us in the Eucharist, then finally, how He shares a human heart with us, through which He guides us to his divine Heart.

We are truly blessed: we have come to know God and, although we can never fully *understand* Him, we can *know* Him, and follow Him, and love Him, and worship Him. Because He became one of us, died for us, and rose for us, to give us a share in his own life.

May we celebrate the wonderful news that God is a Trinity of Love, and find in that mystery the root and the source of our all our good loves.

“Blessed be the Holy Trinity and Undivided Unity! We will give glory to Him, because He has shown his mercy to us!”
