

The St. Vincent de Paul Society helps our neighbors who are facing immediate challenges. We want to help you get to know more about our SVDP conference and their efforts by featuring a story from one of our neighbors in need each month.

## A SVDP Story: "Adulting" – A Challenge under the best of circumstances!

Selena is a 24-year-old single woman challenged by mental health issues. She has recently begun therapy, and although the cost of the therapy is covered, she has no paid time off. She works minimum wage and makes little enough as it is. Trying to be responsible, she had put all her bills on "auto-pay" so that she would not miss payments. That would be okay with fixed-amount payments, but her utility bill during the summer heat spiked – and Auto-Pay grabbed the payment before she could pay her rent! We were able to help her out with the shortfall, but just as important, we connected her with a staff person at Catholic Charities who can help her with applying for food stamps, discounted RTD fare, discounted internet, and overall budgeting. "Adulting" is a challenge even under the best of circumstances! No one should have to do it alone.

#### **OUR OCTOBER MOTHER'S STORY**

Hope came to Marisol Health-Denver through her sister, who received care during her pregnancies. Hope had been told by previous medical providers that she and her husband were infertile. After many years of trying and struggling with many losses, Hope and her husband started the adoption process. Following an adoption appointment, Hope came to Marisol Health on a whim to inquire about fertility options. After beginning treatment, Hope found out that she was pregnant, which was met with both surprise and immense joy. Shortly after finding out, she was pregnant, Hope lost her job and she and her family had to transition to being fully reliant on her husband's income. Hope was introduced to the support of a Marisol baby shower following one of her OB appointments early on in her pregnancy. Hope was overjoyed and relieved knowing that she and her husband could bring their baby into the world with support from the community, while living paycheck to paycheck. Hope and her husband are elated to be welcoming their child in a couple of months and are incredibly grateful for the help with baby items.
