# IN MEMORY OF ROBERT BLASI SEPT 24, 1930 - SEPT 27, 2023

Committal Services were held at Fort Logan National Cemetery by Deacon Don Schaefer on November 2 for former parishioner Robert Blasi. Born on September 24, 1930, in Cunningham, Kansas, Bob died in Littleton, on September 27, 2023, at the age of 93. He

grew up in Pratt, Kansas, served in the U.S. Navy, and earned a BS degree from Colorado A&M (CSU). He married Anne on June 30, 1954; they had been married for 67 years when she died in 2021. Bob joined the football coaching staff at Colorado State College (UNC) in 1955 and was head coach from 1966-1985 during which they had over 100 wins and an undefeated season in 1969. # HOLY NAME ST. VINCENT DE PAUL SOCIETY SERVING OUR NEIGHBORS IN NEED

The St. Vincent de Paul Society helps our neighbors who are facing immediate challenges. We want to help you get to know more about our SVDP conference and their efforts by featuring a story from one of our neighbors in need each month.

# A SVDP Story: "Financial Worries"

Fifteen years ago, Maria's daughter abandoned her two young children and went down the dark road of drug abuse. Maria took them in and raised them. When we visited her four years ago, the older one had graduated high school, the younger one was a sophomore, and Maria had just been diagnosed with end-stage renal disease. We heard from a property manager that Maria was having "financial worries," so we paid her a visit. With dialysis for the renal disease and insulin for diabetes, she has managed to see her grandson complete a 2-year college degree ("praise God!"); he is employed and on his own. The granddaughter graduated high school, is employed, lives with grandma, and helps with the rent and groceries. Over the four years since our last visit, Maria's Social Security benefit has increased 16.2%, from \$860 to \$1,000 - but her rent has increased 50.2%, from \$529 to \$795. So yes, there are "financial worries" on the horizon. We helped her out with \$400 toward October rent.

### **OUR NOVEMBER MOTHER'S STORY**

Heather is a teenager who initially found Marisol Health to receive support and care for her unexpected pregnancy. She was a sophomore in high school when she first came through our doors and expressed fear and anxiety for what this pregnancy could mean for her and her boyfriend. For the first few visits, Heather was still undecided about the pregnancy and seriously considering having an abortion, "because this just wasn't supposed to happen this way. It feels really chaotic and confusing to think about having a baby." She shared that she is currently living with her grandparents due to not having a good relationship with her mother and expressed fear that she would get "kicked out if they found out I was pregnant." Through the support of the Marisol Health Family Development Specialist and counseling team as well as the consistent care and attention she received in her medical appointments, Heather eventually shared the news with her family and received support from her aunt and, unexpectedly, her friends and extended family have rallied around both she and her boyfriend and this unborn child! Heather and her boyfriend have decided to continue with the pregnancy and express feeling "nervous but excited to meet this little one in December." Heather consistently states how grateful she is for the support of the Marisol Health staff and community, even sharing "We couldn't have done this without you guys." Her boyfriend has found steady employment, and they are enrolled in Medicaid and have consistent transportation and housing. Heather expresses her gratitue for the support of these material resources and excitement at being able to be a mother for her unborn child.
