FROM FR. DANIEL

Dear brothers and sisters,

The end of the liturgical year, which leads to a new Advent, is always an invitation to honor Jesus Christ, the King of the Universe.

The portrait of our King, as we hear in the readings, is quite different from any idea of a king we may have. We hear today about a King whose main concern is for his little ones. A King that is not afraid of the low service of being a shepherd: not just hiring shepherds to care for his flock, but, as He says, I myself will look after and tend my sheep. A King who in his final judgment will ask not about taxes or lands or other tributes, but about what we did or did not do for his little ones. A King that, in his extreme love and solidarity, becomes the little one himself: what you did not do for one of these least ones, you did not do for me.

As the King invites us to join his Kingdom in an ever-fuller way, may we, first, recognize that we are his sheep, the little ones He cares for, and second, that we must care for those who suffer, in whom He is present, in whom we honor our King.
