Dear brothers and sisters,

**FROM FR. DANIEL**

As we continue our journey towards a renewed encounter with the Lord, today we pray with the whole Church in the Collect that “no earthly undertaking may hinder those who set out in haste to meet your Son.” This is an important warning for these busy weeks: there can be earthly undertakings, even good ones, that can impede our encounter with Christ. Therefore, a brief examination is in place.

The busyness of our many earthly undertakings may block our view and keep the eyes of our mind occupied with things that, not necessarily being bad, keep us far from Christ who comes.

This is even more relevant because He comes in ways that are not always our first choice. He comes in his Body, and He has a predilection for coming to meet us in the person of the poor, the materially and spiritually poor. And just as at his first coming too many people missed his presence because they were busy and ignored a poor family, so today this can happen to us as well. This is why we pray now for this grace, that no earthly undertaking may be an obstacle for meeting Christ, who comes to us also in those who need our charity.
