### FROM FR. DANIEL

Brothers and sisters,

The attentiveness and watchfulness of Advent, so evident in the first Sunday, lead us on the second Sunday to think of the concrete dispositions they demand. For this, St. John the Baptist, one of the protagonists of this season, makes an appearance today.

The Gospel begins with this simple statement: *the Gospel of Jesus Christ the Son of God*. These are words that sound familiar to us, and yet, they are a careful selection of powerful statements: the good news of Jesus, the Messiah, who is the (only) Son of God. This man Jesus is the expected Messiah, and this man is God. He is the one Savior, the Redeemer.

The Gospel, the proclamation of the good news of Jesus begins with the announcement of John the Baptist: *prepare the way of the Lord; make straight his paths*. There is no way to receive the good news if not by being attentive and preparing our hearts for the news He brings. Conversion is at the center of the gospel.
