**APR 10, 1941 - NOV 22, 2024**

Marilyn Ritter, age 83, a lifelong Colorado native and a long-time Holy Name parishioner, died on November 22, 2024, at The Ridge. Born on April 10, 1941, in Denver to Charles and Mildred Greenhalgh, she graduated from South High School, the Colorado Women's College in Denver, and Colorado College in Colorado Springs where she earned an MA in Education.

She began her career teaching kindergarten in the Littleton school district. Later, she transitioned to managing her father's medical practice while raising her two children, RuthAnn and Kevin. Marilyn married Kenneth Ritter in 1967 and resided in the same Littleton home for 53 years until Kenny's passing in 2021.

Marilyn was a devoted member of her parish, where she taught CCD classes for many years and loved decorating the church for Christmas. She also enjoyed gardening and travel. She will be buried in Fairmont Cemetery.
