FROM FR. DANIEL

Dear brothers and sisters,

The fourth candle of our Advent wreath will barely burn, for, as we know, this year the fourth Sunday of Advent falls on December 24. The fourth candle will adorn the wreath with its light for less than a day. What a waste, we may think!

What matters in life is not quantity, but quality. What truly matters is holiness. Whether the fourth candle will be used for a full week or for a day is not as relevant as whether it will burn and shed its light and warmth.

A week ago, we heard of John the Baptist coming to testify to the light. On the night of Christmas, the glory of God shone and dispelled the darkness with the presence of the newborn Jesus. And today, as we prepare to celebrate again his Nativity, we are invited to receive his light, to become and share that light. We know all too well how dark things are now. But we won't allow the darkness to penetrate our hearts, our families, our parish. Today the light of the Nativity fills with joy and hope. May we be willing to truly burn like that candle... How long and in what way, that is up to God. Let's receive the light.
