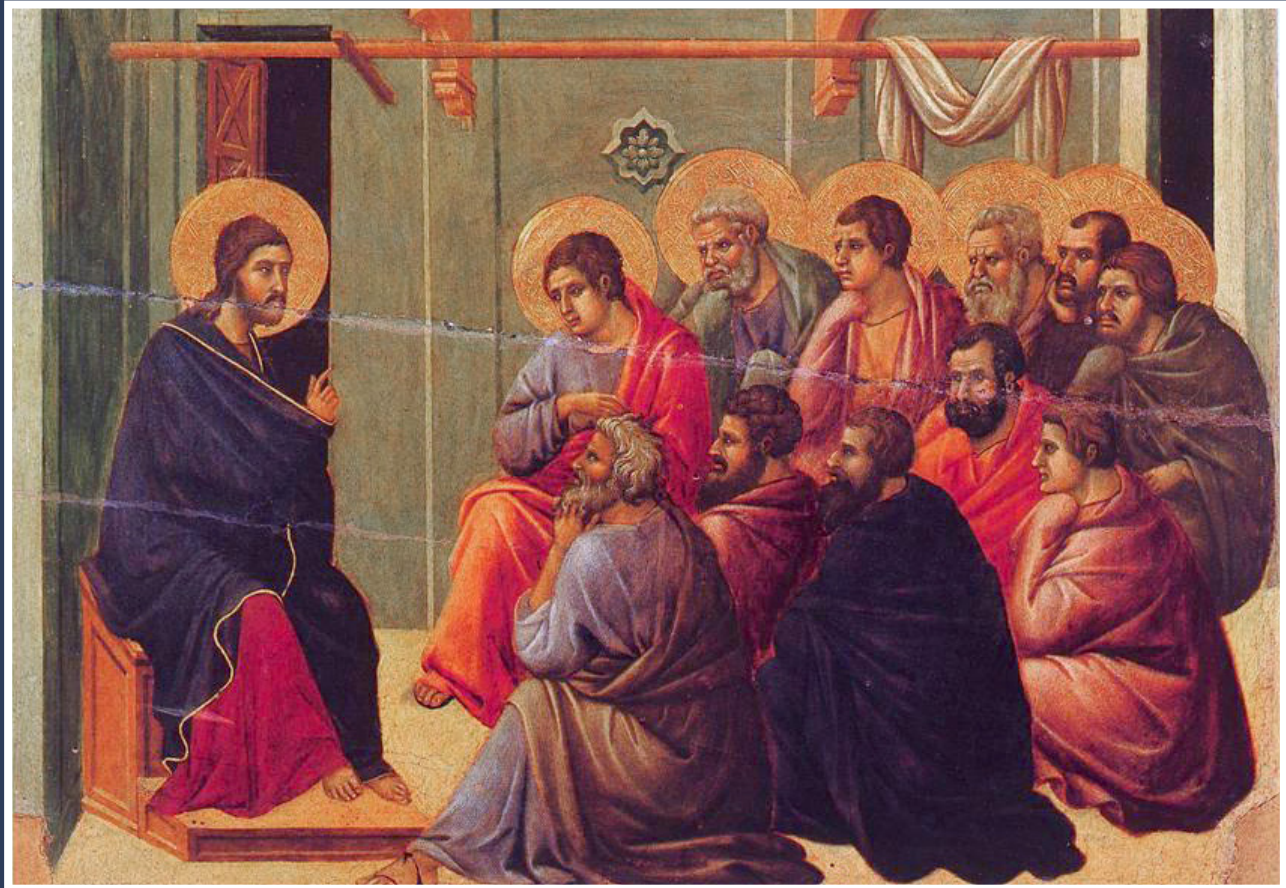

Dear friends in Christ,

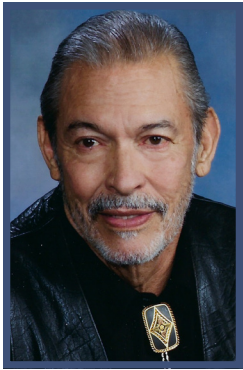

PARISH FUNERAL NOTICE



CARLOS DEHERRERA JUNE 7, 1946 - MAY 2, 2023

Carlos DeHerrera, 76, an active Holy Name parishioner for more than 55 years, died on Tuesday, May 2, 2023, after sustaining injuries in an automobile crash. Born on June 7, 1946, in Mora, New Mexico, he graduated from the Mora High School. Carlos served in the U.S. Army during the Vietnam Era between 1965 and 1968.

On April 20, 1968, he married Elsie Trujillo at Our Lady of Grace Church, Denver. They have two sons: Michael and Arvin, nine grandchildren and 10 great-grandchildren. Carlos had five brothers and one sister. A mechanic and sheet metal worker, he had been employed by Kloppenberg Co.

Carlos was a member of the Knights of Columbus for more than 31 years, holding many officer positions including Grand Knight twice, and being a member of the 4th Degree Assembly. He was a leader in the Keep Christ in Christmas program among other Knights activities. He was active in the parish serving as an usher, an extraordinary minister of Holy Communion, and singing in the choir for a number of years. He and Elsie were involved in the Our Lady of Fatima Prayer Ministry and were part of the team that was instrumental in erecting the Our Lady of Guadalupe monument at Holy Name.

Carlos was also a member of the VFW Post 9644 and the American Legion. In lieu of flowers, the family suggests giving blood in Carlos' name or donations to the Vitalant Blood Bank, 5066 S. Wadsworth, Suite 111, Littleton, CO (vitalent.org).

A Vigil Rosary Service will be held Sunday, May 14, at 5pm in the Church; his funeral Mass will be Monday, May 15 at 10am with burial at Fort Logan National Cemetery at 11:30am. A reception will follow in the Saint Agnes Center, all are invited to attend!
