HELEN (MAREZ) JOHN JUNE 12, 1928 - JUNE 28, 2023



Mrs. Helen John, age 95, a parishioner at Holy Name for more than 63 years, passed away in Englewood, Colorado, at Swedish Hospital on June 28, 2023, following surgery for a broken hip.

A Funeral Mass was celebrated on Monday, July 10. She was buried at Fort Logan National Cemetery on Wednesday, July 12.

Born to Jose and Jessica (Candelaria) Marez on June 12, 1928, in Mancos, Colorado,

Helen grew up on a 44-acre ranch near Mancos. She had two brothers, and attended Cortez public schools.

Helen was baptized on September 27, 1928. She moved to the Denver area in 1948.

Helen married Earl John on November 2, 1948, in Palisade, Colorado, after having met him only two weeks prior. They had been married for 58 years when Earl died in January 2006. They had three children: Jessica, Fred, and David, four grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren.

Helen was primarily a homemaker, however, she also worked as a caretaker and cleaned homes.

Dear friends in Christ,

FROM FR. DANIEL

The Lord Jesus teaches us again those same lessons found in those same parables which we have heard so many times. Is that a waste of time? It would be if we needed new ideas for motivation. But we need depth, and his word is always new. Today that word comes to us again through the liturgy of the Church: the seed falls on the ground of our heart. Will anything happen?

Christ wants that seed to fall in good, fertile, deep soil. If we choose to be open, and listen, and receive, and reflect, then the word—as we hear in the first reading—won't return to God void, but will produce fruit. How amazing it is to consider that the proclamation of the word is not mere teaching but an event, a presence, the intervention of the living God speaking today to his Church through his living word. This event can make a difference for each one of us today. We just need to be receptive.

May we ask Mary to teach us how to receive God's word in our hearts in a fruitful way.
