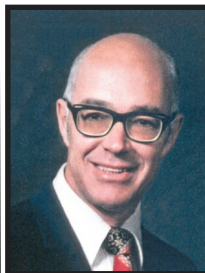

## IN MEMORY OF LEO BONACCI



A funeral Mass for Leo Bonacci, age 99 and 10 months was held Thursday, February 2nd.

Leo was born March 24, 1923 in Toltec, Colorado to Dan and Jean Bonacci. He grew up in the Alamo Coal Mining Camp until he was 13, when the family moved into Walsenburg.

Leo served in the U.S. Army as a combat engineer in World War II in Europe. He received a BS degree in Accounting from CU and later he earned an MBA degree from the University of Denver. He was in a delayed vocations seminary, but within a year resigned and married Lavina Stumpf on June 2, 1962 in Pierz, Minnesota at the age of 39.

Leo and Lavina had four children: Mary Beth, Paul, David and Julie (Shaw), and five grandchildren: Anna, Brian, Audrey, Leo and Ava. He worked in the oil and gas industry as a CPA.

While he and his wife were members of Our Lady of Fatima Church for many years, they began attending Holy Name several years ago with their daughter Mary Beth.

Leo was laid to rest with Lavina at Fort Logan National Cemetery.

## PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear friends,

We all have received a great treasure: faith in Christ. Without personal merit, we have come to know the Lord Jesus, we have learned to love Him, and we are called to announce his love. As Jesus says today, "a lamp cannot be put under a bushel basket." We cannot hide the luminous treasure we have received!

For many, the call to mission finds a common obstacle: how can I speak of Him if I am not prepared, if I have not studied theology, and don't know how to eloquently convince others? St. Paul shares with us his own testimony, "I came to you in weakness and fear and much trembling, and my message and my proclamation were not with persuasive words of wisdom." Paul did one thing: he proclaimed Christ, and Him crucified. We don't need to be the best speakers or the most learned scholars; we need to love Jesus and share that love with those around us, in whichever way it works. The Lord wants friends who can become witnesses. May we be available to this invitation.
