PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear brothers and sisters,

Today the splendor of the Nativity shines for every
 person as we celebrate the Epiphany of the Lord, his
 manifestation as the one Savior of the world.

Of all the rich aspects of this celebration, so
 embedded in traditions and folklore, we should think
 about the power of the universal revelation of Christ. In
 one sense, our first reaction could be not really caring
 about that, for we all already know Him. But there are two
 points that do matter for us. First, while we all know of
 Christ, that doesn't mean we have fully accepted his truth
 and love; salvation is an invitation, and it requires our
 free assent. Therefore, the universal character of Christ's
 salvation means also the totality of our yes, our assent to
 his plan without conditions. Second, the universality of
 Christ's love makes us think about the fact that many
 people don't know his salvation: whether they haven't
 heard of it or haven't truly appreciated it. Therefore, today
 we are called to share his love with those who are far
 from it.

May this great solemnity move us to rejoice in this
 amazing salvation that shines today for all.
