PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear friends in Christ,

Lent is a time of renewal. The Lord gives another year to cultivate the ground of our heart so that it can bear fruit. This is not only a call to do things, it is a call of love, a Heart that speaks to another heart. Traditionally, the Church has read for centuries today, the text of the Samaritan woman and her encounter with Christ at the well. As St. Augustine said, "Jesus was thirsty for her faith. And she recognized in Him the One she was waiting for."

God speaks to us; He reveals his name to us, as He did to Moses. He is burning with love for us. Lent is about his: love, desire, thirst. May we renew our longing for God, so that this year, the Lord can see some real fruit of conversion after these days of penance.
