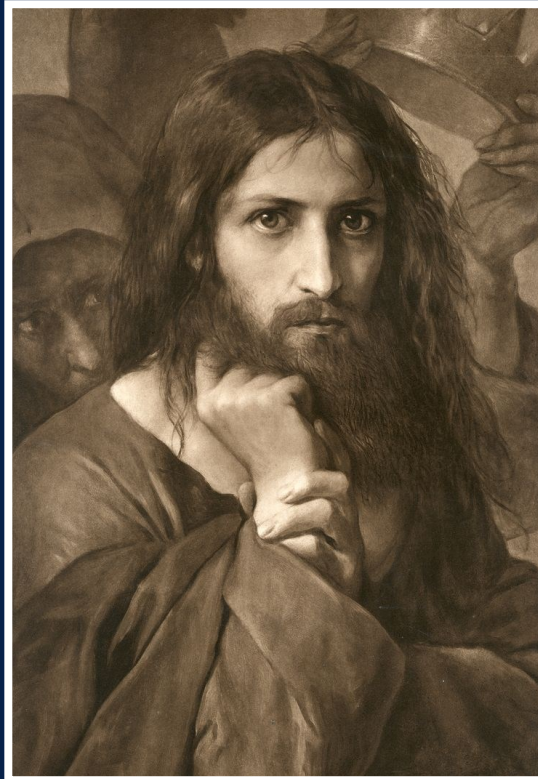

## FASTING & ABSTINENCE DURING LENT:

All Catholics, 14 years of age and older are obligated to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

All Catholics ages 18-59 are also bound to observe the law of fasting on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday with one full meatless meal and with the option of two smaller meatless meals that together are not equal to one full meal.

In addition, all Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding from age 14 onwards.

If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday evening) as the 'paschal fast' to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily his Resurrection.

**OLD PALMS** will be burned in the fire at the Easter Vigil. You may place any you have in the bin in the church narthex.
