Funeral Services for Susie Atencio will be held Wednesday, October 26th. A rosary will be prayed at 9:15am with the Mass at 10:00am at Holy Name Catholic Parish and a reception to follow.

Susie died Saturday, October 8th after a short illness. She had been a Holy Name parishioner for over 44 years.

Born on July 31, 1933 in Wheatland, Wyoming, Susie lived in Denver her entire life and she was the 7th of 13 children. Susie and George, her late husband had two sons: George II and Christopher, eight grandchildren and eight great-grandchildren.

She was very active in the Women's Auxiliary of the Knights of Columbus in downtown Denver. Susie served in various state offices including President.

For many years, Susie and George would head out every Wednesday morning to fill their truck with food that otherwise would be discarded by several grocery stores, delivering the food to food banks and Catholic services.

Susie will be laid to rest on October 27th at 1:00pm at Fort Logan National Cemetery.

**PASTOR'S CORNER**

Dear brothers and sisters,

It is always important to be sincerely open to the words we hear at Mass. Today we hear a parable told for those who were convinced of their own righteousness. Often we hear about the Pharisees and think about some extreme group of people far from us. But, when we think more about it, and realize that we do keep good practices, and pray, and fast, and tithe, and know our faith, then we can probably see that we too can be one of those who are convinced of their own righteousness. This is why we should take to heart what we hear, so that we can learn how to pray: as one who is in need of salvation, and like the tax collector, can be made righteous by the mercy of the Lord.

May this healthy warning lead us to the humility necessary to let God work more fruitfully in our lives.
