The story of Zacchaeus makes us think about our need for mercy and conversion. However, this story is not only about a one-time past experience of encountering Christ and making an initial choice to follow Him. Zacchaeus invites us to understand that we need to seek Christ, knowing Him in an ever deeper way, and that because of this, we must move and be willing to overcome any obstacles.

As for Zacchaeus, we also live surrounded by a crowd. It might be the crowd of work and busyness, of distraction and opinions. Unless we are willing to do whatever is needed—such as climbing a tree—we won't be able to find Jesus anew. But—we can be sure of it—if we do look for Him, He will meet us, and come to us. Like Zacchaeus, we must welcome Him with joy and respond with a concrete change.

This story unfolds for each one of us in different ways. May we be open to Christ, who wants us to seek his face to give us the joy of a renewed communion with Him.

- We helped 156 families (220 adults, 147 children) who live within our parish boundaries† and north of our parish as far as Yale Avenue.
- In addition to the \$91,510 in assistance noted above, we applied for and distributed \$22,283 from Energy Outreach Colorado for assistance with utilities, \$2,124 from the Daniels Fund for an emergency situation, and distributed \$1,700 in donated gift cards. *(Not included is the value of furniture donated to us for the benefit of neighbors we helped.)*
- We also arranged two Fresh Start Loans through Fidelis Catholic Credit Union at a very low interest rate to relieve credit card debt.
