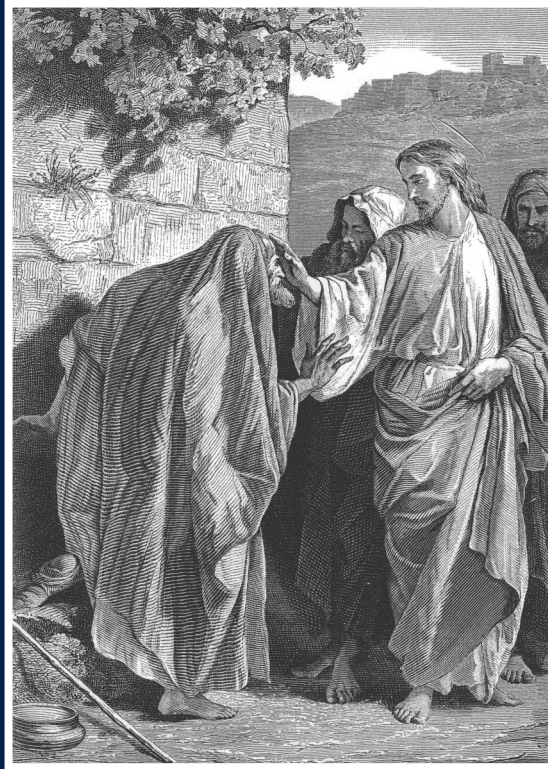

IN MEMORY OF JAMES E. GREICHEN

A Funeral Mass was held on Tuesday, October 4th for Jim Greichen, a long-time parishioner at Holy Name. He passed away on September 19, 2022 at the age of 93.

Born March 8, 1929, in Newport, Rhode Island, he was a lifelong, faithful Catholic. Jim was married to Pat for 65 years. They had four children; Jim, Mike, Mary and Jack, nine grand children and eight great grandchildren.

Jim joined the Knights of Columbus October 1954. At Holy Name, he served the KC Council as treasurer and Grand Knight. Jim had been a Holy Name parishioner for some 37 years.
